An Act relative to emergency medical services at certain prison facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general of special law to the contrary, the department of correction  
2 shall establish and maintain emergency medical and ambulatory services at Bay State  
3 Correctional Center and MCI-Cedar Junction. Upon passage of this act the department of  
4 correction shall be solely responsible for the emergency care and transportation for all incidents  
5 that occur at said facilities.
