An Act relative to the contribution for insurance premiums of certain retired employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9E of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is amended by inserting at the end of the last sentence thereof the following  
3 words:- ; provided, however, that the per cent of premium paid by a retired employee, at any  
4 time, will not be higher than the per cent of premium paid upon retirement.
