The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Carol Poyer, an employee of the Department of Youth Services.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of youth services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the 2 department of youth services shall establish a sick leave bank for Carol Poyer, an employee of 3 the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, 4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Carol Poyer. Whenever Carol Poyer 5 terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any 6 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick 7 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that 8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
