An Act establishing a sick leave for John B. Resendes, Jr., an employee of the Department of Corrections.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special, or rule or regulation to the contrary,  
2 the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for John B. Resendes, Jr., an employee of the  
3 Department of Corrections. Any employee of said department may voluntarily contribute 1 or  
4 more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by John B. Resendes, Jr.  
5 Whenever John B. Resendes, Jr. terminates employment with said department or request to  
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave bank time shall be transferred to the  
7 trial court paid sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to  
8 the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined  
9 by the department
