An Act relative to disability pension benefits and earnings reports.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 91A of said chapter 32, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended in line 9 by inserting after the word “commission’ the following words:- ,  
3 provided, however, that the commission may waive such filing by a member, if said member  
4 shall have been retired for more than ten years, and has not reported any earnings for the prior  
5 five years and also signs an affidavit under the pains and penalties of perjury indicating that  
6 should he/she realize any earned income in the future that they will forthwith notify the  
7 commission of that fact and again report under this Section.
