## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen  
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An Act expanding insurance choices for state and local employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following:-

3           Among the policies purchased by the commission, at least one shall include a health  
4   savings account in its design.

5           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
