**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act relative to an automatic reduction in the sales tax.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The executive office for administration and finance and the office of the  
2 state treasurer, in consultation with the department of revenue and the senate and house  
3 committees on ways and means, shall study the feasibility of establishing a schedule for an  
4 automatic reduction in the sales tax to 5 per cent if certain thresholds in revenue growth are  
5 exceeded. The executive office for administration and finance and the office of the state  
6 treasurer shall submit a final report of its findings and recommendations, together with drafts of  
7 legislation necessary to implement those recommendations, by filing the same with the clerks of  
8 the senate and house not later than December 31, 2013.
