1           SECTION 1. Section 21 A1/2 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2   2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 6 the words “as a Certified  
3   Massachusetts Assessor” and inserting in place thereof, “as a Massachusetts Accredited  
4   Assessor,”
