*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1            Clause (i) of Section 6 of Chapter 62 as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after the word “commonwealth” in line 270 the following phase:-  
3            “any resident over the age of 65 shall be eligible regardless of the tax imposed by this  
4 chapter”
