An Act eliminating the motor vehicle excise tax in the fifth and succeeding years.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Chapter 60A: Section 1 of the General Laws is amended by removing  
2   “10%” after “in the fifth and succeeding years” and inserting the word “none”.
