### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act providing non-certified copies of records.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 19 of Chapter 46 of the General Laws, as appearing in the General Laws, is
hereby amended by adding the following section:

3 "Section 19D: The custodians of birth, marriage, and death records will provide non-

4 certified copies of records on plain paper rather than safety paper. These copies will be marked

5 "for research purposes only, not to be used as evidence." The cost will be 20% of the cost of a

6 certified copy."
