**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**

An Act relative to traffic safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph 1 of section 18A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the words:- “One dollar for  
3 the first second and third such offense committed in a calendar year, and by a fine of two dollars  
4 for the fourth or subsequent offense in a calendar year”, and inserting in place thereof:- “twenty-  
5 five dollars for the first offense, fifty dollars for the second offense, and seventy-five dollars for  
6 the third and subsequent offenses.”
