An Act relative to certain alcoholic liquor licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended in section 15 by  
2 inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3 “; provided, however, any person or entity who holds licenses under both this section and  
4 section 18 or 19, which licenses were granted prior to January 1, 2011, shall be entitled to obtain  
5 licenses under this section in accordance with the other provisions of this section.”
