An Act providing for the enhanced protection of the dig safe law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           Section 40A of chapter 82 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserted at the end thereof the following:-
- 3           To receive a building permit from any city, town, or political subdivision, for any work  
4 requiring excavation, the individual shall provide certification of compliance with this section.  
5 The designation markings required by this section shall be performed by a trained utility  
6 employee.
