An Act relative to designating Route 18 in New Bedford to honor the Edward M. Kennedy Historical Waterfront Boulevard.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The portion of Route 18 in New Bedford that runs from Elm Street to  
2 Walnut Street shall be designated and known as the Edward M. Kennedy Historic Waterfront  
3 Boulevard, in honor of the dedication and service of Edward M. Kennedy to the citizens of the  
4 Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the United States of America. The Department of  
5 Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance  
6 with the standards of the department.
