The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act designating a Gold Star Highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The length of highway, currently referred to as route 44, that runs between 2 route 3 in the town of Plymouth in a westerly direction for a distance of 14.4 miles to interstate 3 highway route 495 in the town of Middleborough, shall be designated and known as the Gold 4 Star Highway in recognition of the brave men and women who died while actively serving in our 5 nation's armed services. The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and 6 maintain suitable markers bearing that designation in compliance with the standards of the 7 department.
