An Act relative to disabled veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 6C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof a new subsection:-

3           (d) Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, any  
4 vehicle registered to any veteran deemed 100 per cent disabled by the Veterans' Administration  
5 of the United States government shall be exempt from paying any toll on the turnpike or  
6 metropolitan highway system or any other toll that may be assessed under this section. The  
7 department shall within one year of the effective date of this act promulgate rules and regulations  
8 to carry out the requirement under this subsection.
