An Act prohibiting tolls on the Massachusetts Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 6C of the General Laws as appearing in the 2010
2 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking subsection (18).

3 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other general or special law to the contrary the
4 department of transportation shall not charge or collect tolls for transit on interstate highway
5 route 90.
