Resolve relative to the reimbursement of Chester Gorski.

- 1 Resolved, That for the purpose of reimbursing Major General Chester E. Gorski, Massachusetts
- 2 Army National Guard, for legal expenses incurred in defending himself in a civil complaint
- 3 initiated by the then Adjutant General Raymond A. Vezina, and after appropriation has been
- 4 made therefore, there shall be paid to Major General Gorski the sum of \$30,136.94. Said
- 5 complaint having been subsequently withdrawn and Major General Gorski having acted properly
- and in good faith as a member of the Massachusetts Militia in submitting complaints regarding
- 7 activities within the Massachusetts National Guard.
