By Mr. Kennedy, a petition (subject to Joint Rule 12) of Thomas P. Kennedy for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Robert James Boucher, an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Robert James Boucher, an employee of the Department of Correction.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith to establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of corrections, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the
2 contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for Robert James Boucher, an employee
3 of the department of corrections. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1
4 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Robert James Boucher.
5 Whenever Robert James Boucher terminates employment with the department or requests to
6 dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the
7 extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the
8 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by
9 the department.
