By Ms. Lovely, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1790) of Joan Lovely and Bradford Hill (by vote of the town) for legislation to authorize the issuance of a certain license for the retail sale of wine to be consumed on the premises in the town of Topsfield. Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure. [Local Approval Received.]

### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act authorizing the town of Topsfield to grant a license for the sale of wine to be drunk on the premises of a farmer-winery.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 11, 15, 15F, 17 and 19B of

- chapter 138 of the general laws, or of any other general or special law to the contrary, the
- licensing authority of the Town of Topsfield is authorized to grant to the Alfalfa Farm Winery at
  Rowley Bridge Road, Topsfield, provided that said owner meets all other requirements for
- 5 the issuance of the license and holds a Farmer Winery license issued by the Commonwealth of
- 6 Massachusetts under section 19B of said chapter 138, a license for the retail sale of wine
- 7 produced by or for said Winery and sold under the winery brand name, poured by the glass, to be
- 8 drunk on the premises. The license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except as set forth
- 9 herein. The licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license to any applicant or to
- any other location.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage
