An Act exempting certain employees from the Northampton retirement system.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the  
2 contrary, the city of Northampton retirement board may exclude Charlotte Carver and Mary Ann  
3 Tourjee, employees of the Lilly Library, an employing unit recently added to the Northampton  
4 Retirement System, from mandatory membership in the retirement system based upon their  
5 unique individual circumstances and the likelihood that they will not be eligible for a potential  
6 pension benefit.
