The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Cynthia (Bouchard) White, an employee of the Trial Court.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the trial court, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience., therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public [Emergency Preamble Context].

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regulation to the
2 contrary, the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for Cynthia (Bouchard) White, an
3 employee of the Massachusetts Trial Court, Essex County Juvenile Court. Any employee of the
4 trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave
5 bank for use by Cynthia (Bouchard) White. Whenever Cynthia (Bouchard) White terminates
6 employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time
7 in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank
8 days shall not be used for absence unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the
9 establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court.
