An Act relative to the Falmouth Historic District Commission.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 654 of the Acts of 1975 is hereby further amended by adding the  
2 following to Section 7.

3           Section 7 (A)    The commission shall hold a hearing on any application and shall  
4 give public notice of the time, place and purposes thereof by posting notice with the Town Clerk  
5 7 days in advance of the meeting. Notice shall also be sent by regular mail to property owners  
6 within 100 feet of any part of the land of the applicant who are also within the historic district.  
7 Or do or take any other action on this matter.
