An Act exempting Barry Canavan from the maximum age requirement as a firefighter in the town of Westwood.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 58, 61A and 61B of Chapter 31 of the General  
2 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, Barry Canavan of the Town of  
3 Rockland may have his name certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in  
4 the Town of Westwood, notwithstanding having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil  
5 service examination in connection with such appointment. In all other respects, Barry Canavan  
6 shall be eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter in the Town of Westwood only  
7 insofar as he qualifies and is selected for employment under Chapter 31 of the General Laws,  
8 any regulations of the Civil Service Commission and any lawful hiring practices of the Town of  
9 Westwood.

10           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
