By Mr. Brewer, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1960) of Stephen M. Brewer and Todd M. Smola for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Katrina Aliengena, an employee of the Department of Developmental Services. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Katrina Aliengena, an employee of the Department of Developmental Services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department
2 of developmental services shall establish a sick leave bank for Katrina Aliengena, an employee
3 of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Katrina Aliengena. Whenever Katrina
5 Aliengena terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave
6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave
7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
8 that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
