An Act directing the police department of the city of Boston to waive the maximum age requirement for police officer Edward Grace.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, including the  
2 provisions of Chapter 43 of the Acts of 2007, the City of Boston Police Department shall waive  
3 the maximum age requirement for original appointment for police officer Edward Grace. If  
4 Edward Grace meets all other requirements set forth by the Boston Police Department, he shall  
5 be eligible to have his name certified for original appointment to the position of police officer.

6           Section 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect immediately upon passage.
