An Act to expand the sale of products by farmer breweries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "farmer-winery license under 3 section 19B or from any other state" in lines 65-66 the following words:- or a farmer-brewery 4 license under section 19C or from any other state 5 SECTION 2. Said section 12 of said chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby further 6 amended by inserting after the words "such wine" in line 68 the following words:- or beer 7 SECTION 3. Said section 12 of said chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby further 8 amended by inserting after the words "premises of the winery" in line 68 the following words:-9 or brewery 10 SECTION 4. Section 15 of said chapter 138, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
