An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Cynthia Salsman, an employee of the Soldiers’ Home in Massachusetts.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the Soldiers’ Home in Massachusetts located in the city of Chelsea shall establish a sick  
3 leave bank for Cynthia Salsman, an employee of the Soldiers’ Home. Any employee of the  
4 Soldiers’ Home may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick  
5 leave bank for use by Cynthia Salsman. Whenever Cynthia Salsman terminates employment with  
6 the Soliders’ Home or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick  
7 leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not  
8 be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of  
9 the sick leave bank as determined by the Soldiers’ Home.
