An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Leonard DeMauro, an employee of the Department of Youth Services.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Youth Services, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department  
2 of Youth Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Leonard DeMauro, an employee of the  
3 Hadley Assessment Unit of the Department of Youth Services. Any employee of the Department  
4 of Youth Services may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the  
5 sick leave bank for use by Leonard DeMauro. Whenever Leonard DeMauro terminates  
6 employment with the Department of Youth Services or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,  
7 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the Department of Youth  
8 Services' paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the  
9 illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by  
10 the Department of Youth Services.
