The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen
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An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Needham as the Reverend (Lt.) Daniel J. Kennedy, USN Memorial Bridge.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to designate forthwith a certain bridge in the town of Needham as the Reverend (LT) Daniel J. Kennedy, USN Memorial Bridge, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bridge located on Great Plain Avenue spanning Route 128 in the town
2 of Needham shall be designated and known as the Reverend (LT) Daniel J. Kennedy, USN
3 Memorial Bridge, in honor of Father Daniel J. Kennedy, a U.S. Navy Chaplain. The
4 Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing
5 the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
