By Mr. DiDomenico, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2185) of Sal N. DiDomenico and Daniel Ryan for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Margaret Poindexter, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Margaret Poindexter, an employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall establish a sick leave bank for Margaret
3 Poindexter, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily
4 contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Janet
5 Everett. Whenever Margaret Poindexter terminates employment with the department or requests
6 to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to
7 the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to
8 the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined
9 by the department.
