By Mr. Donnelly, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2233) of Kenneth J. Donnelly, Jay R. Kaufman and James J. Dwyer (with the approval of the mayor and city council) for legislation to authorize the licensing authority of the city of Woburn to issue additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act authorizing the licensing authority of the city of Woburn to issue additional licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the licensing authority of the City of Woburn may grant six (6) licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises under Section 12 of said Chapter 138. The licenses shall be subject to all of said Chapter 138, except Section 17.
 - Section 2. The licensing authority of the City of Woburn shall restrict the licenses granted under Sections 1 and 2 of this Act as to number and to persons, corporations, organizations, and entities located in the following locations:
 - (a) Three (3) licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on premises to be available for the property known as 369 Washington Street, as more specifically shown on a plan which is on file with the City Clerk of the City of Woburn.
- 11 (b) Two (2) licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on premises 12 known as 399 Washington Street, as more specifically shown on a plan which is on file with the 13 City Clerk of the City of Woburn.
- 14 (c) One (1) license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on premises to 15 the property and building presently known as The Crestview Plaza, 36 Montvale Avenue, 16 Woburn, Massachusetts as more specifically shown on a plan which is on file with the City Clerk

of the City of Woburn.
