# SENATE . . . . . No. 2290

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By Ms. O'Connor Ives, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2290) of Kathleen O'Connor Ives and Diana DiZoglio for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Richard Bravoco an employee of the Department of Correction. Public Service.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen  
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An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Richard Bravoco, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of correction, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department  
2 of correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Richard Bravoco, an employee of the  
3 department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of sick,  
4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Richard Bravoco. Whenever Richard  
5 Bravoco terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,  
6 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.  
7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that  
8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department.
