An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Norma Brown, an employee of the Department of Youth Services.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of this state department, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of Youth  
2 Services shall establish a sick leave bank for Norma Brown, an employee of the Department of  
3 Youth Services. Any employee of the Department of Youth Services may voluntarily contribute  
4 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Norma Brown.  
5 Whenever Norma Brown terminates employment with the Department of Youth Services or  
6 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
7 transferred to Department of Youth Services' paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be  
8 used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the  
9 sick leave bank as determined by the Department of Youth Services.
