By Mr. Rosenberg, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 2406) of Stanley C. Rosenberg and Paul W. Mark (with the approval of the mayor and town council) for legislation relative to the special election in the city known as the town of Greenfield. Election Laws. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Fourteen

An Act relative to the special election in the city known as the town of Greenfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a
2 special election in the city known as the town of Greenfield shall be held on Tuesday, April 14,
3 2015 for the purpose of authorizing the creation of a municipal telecommunications system. The
4 polls shall be open from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. Notification shall be posted in the regular
5 polling place and published in a local newspapers at least 14 days before the special election. All
6 other dates set forth in the laws pertaining to the election shall apply.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
