An Act relative to the special election in the city known as the town of Greenfield.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           “SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a special  
2 election in the city known as the town of Greenfield may be held on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 to  
3 authorize the creation of a municipal telecommunications system; provided, however, that polls  
4 shall be open from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M; and provided further, that notification shall be  
5 posted in the regular polling place and published in a local newspaper at least 14 days before the  
6 special election. All other dates set forth in the laws pertaining to the election shall apply.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage."
