An Act relative to redevelopment in the Roxbury area of the city of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1 of chapter 443 of the acts of 1990 is hereby amended by striking out the  
2 definition of “Roxbury Trust Fund Committee” and inserting in place thereof the following  
3 definition:-

4           The “Roxbury Trust Fund Committee” shall mean a committee with a size, membership  
5 and term length determined by the trustees in accordance with the declaration of trust of the  
6 Roxbury Trust Fund Committee Trust, hereinafter the trust, as may be amended by a majority of  
7 the Trustees; provided, however, that such membership shall include, as ex officio trustees, the  
8 sitting state senator of the district and the sitting state representatives of the district or their  
9 designees. The ex officio trustees shall be eligible to vote on amendments to the trust but shall  
10 be non-voting trustees for all other purposes. The Roxbury Trust Fund Committee may: (i)  
11 exercise all powers necessary to carry out the purposes of the trust, including but not limited to  
12 operating for a charitable, scientific, literary or educational purpose; and (ii) raise, collect and  
13 expend funds, property or other assets in furtherance of the purposes of the trust.
