An Act relative to the transfer of funding for recovery high school summer programming.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 91 of chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended, by adding  
2 the following to the end of subsection (b):-

3           For summer programming, a school district shall transfer an amount equal to a prorated  
4 percentage of the state average foundation budget per pupil, based on 180 days, to a Recovery  
5 High School for a student meeting the same criteria.
