An Act relative to residents of nursing homes and assisted living facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after Section 72E the following section:-

3                       Section 72E1/2. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,  
4 nursing home and assisted living facility administrators shall conduct background checks of all  
5 potential residents to promote a safe living environment and for the protection of all current  
6 residents.
