An Act relative to eliminating sub-precincts in the town of Andover.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to eliminate confusion in elections in the town of Andover, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 177 of the Acts of 2011 is hereby amended by striking, in section 1, the words "and sub-precincts 7A and 9A of the town of Andover".
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 177 of the Acts of 2011 is hereby repealed.
