An Act relative to political designations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 38 of Chapter 53 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting in line 19 after the word “primary” the following:- “provided further, that voters  
3 registered with a party or political designation which does not run a candidate shall be  
4 considered unenrolled and shall be eligible to receive a ballot of a political party of their  
5 choosing.”
