By Mr. Tarr, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 411) of Bruce E. Tarr, Michael R. Knapik and Robert L. Hedlund for legislation to reinforce the Massachusetts Endangered Species Act. Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to reinforcing the Massachusetts Endangered Species Act.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION X. Chapter 131A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “thirty-one.” In line 13, the following
3 words:-

4 “Division”, the division of fisheries and wildlife within the department of fisheries,
5 wildlife, and environmental law enforcement.

6 SECTION XX. Chapter 131A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended
7 by inserting, after section 7, the following new sections:-

8 (8) The division shall not promulgate any regulation pursuant to this chapter which may
9 result in the taking or restriction of land, including restrictions resulting from the issuance of a
10 permit, unless such regulation is in accordance with the processes set out in sections 4 and 5 of
11 this chapter and such land is deemed a significant habitat as defined in section 1 of this chapter.

12 (9) The division shall rescind or revise any and all regulations, including, but not limited
13 to 321 CMR 10.11-10.26 et seq., which may involve the taking or restriction of land, including
14 restrictions resulting from the issuance of a permit, unless such regulation is in accordance with
15 the processes set out in sections 4 and 5 of this chapter and such land is deemed a significant
16 habitat as defined in section 1 of this chapter.

17 SECTION XXX. The division shall have 180 days from the passage of this act to rescind
18 or revise regulations pursuant to section 9 of chapter 131A. If after 180 days such regulations are
19 not rescinded, 321 CMR 10.11-10.26 et seq., shall be considered rescinded.
