An Act relative to experienced drivers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the fourteenth paragraph the  
3 following new paragraph:- This section shall not apply to drivers with no at- fault accidents for  
4 10 or more years prior to the date of the third surchargeable incident within the past 24 months.
