## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act reducing the number of uninsured drivers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition
 is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

3 35VV. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth, a
4 separate fund to be known as the Uninsured Drivers Trust Fund to be used, without

appropriation, for the purpose described in section 20 of chapter 90. All monies deposited into
 the fund shall be expended exclusively for the purposes set forth in this section.

SECTION 2. Section 20 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
 amended by adding the following paragraph:-

9 Notwithstanding the foregoing, any person found guilty of attaching an expired or stolen 10 number plate to a motor vehicle, or driving a motor vehicle with an expired or stolen license plate or being in possession of a stolen license plate, shall in addition to the penalties contained 11 12 in this section also be fined \$250. The fine shall be paid to the Uninsured Drivers Trust Fund. Fifty percent of each fine shall be disbursed to the local municipality where the offense occurred 13 and fifty percent shall be distributed to the commissioner of insurance to offset the costs of 14 15 uninsured motorists. The registrar of motor vehicles shall not renew the driver's license of any 16 defendant who has failed to pay the fine imposed by this section.
