An Act eliminating archaic language pertaining to individuals with disabilities in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 32 of chapter 22C of the General Laws, as so appearing in the Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended in the second paragraph on line 12 by deleting the word "handicap" and inserting in place thereof the following:- disability, age,
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended by inserting after the last sentence of the definition for "Handicap", the following:- "Handicap" shall have the same meaning as the term "disability".
- SECTION 3. Clause (e) of subsection 1 of Section 1 of chapter 31A of the General
 Laws, as so appearing in the Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended by deleting on line 22
 the word "handicap" and inserting in place thereof the following:-disability
- SECTION 4. Subsection 2 of section 2 of chapter 31A of the General Laws, as appearing in the Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition for "Department" the following:- "Disability", a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities without regard to the ameliorative effects of mitigating
- measures which do not include ordinary eyeglasses or contact lenses.

15 And, by inserting in section 2 of chapter 31A after the definition for "Local merit appeals" 16 board" the following:-17 Major life activities" shall include, but are not limited to, caring for oneself, performing 18 manual tasks, seeing, hearing, eating, sleeping, walking, standing, lifting, bending, speaking, 19 breathing, learning, reading, concentrating, thinking, communicating, and working. This term 20 also includes the meaning of "major bodily functions," which include, but are not limited to, 21 functions of the immune system, normal cell growth, digestive, bowel, bladder, neurological, 22 brain, respiratory, circulatory, endocrine, and reproductive functions. 23 SECTION 5. Section 23 of chapter 32 of the General Laws as so appearing in the Official 24 Edition of 2010, is hereby amended in clause (5)(b)by deleting the words physical handicap" and 25 inserting the following:- disability 26 SECTION 6. Section 4 of chapter 92B of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 27 Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended in line of 26 by deleting the words "physical 28 handicap", and inserting in their place the following:- disability 29 SECTION 7. The title of section 103 of chapter 93 as so appearing in the Official Edition 30 of 2010, is hereby amended by deleting the word "handicap" and inserting in its place the 31 following:- disability 32 And, in subsection A of section 103 of chapter 93, by deleting in the first sentence the 33 word "handicap" and inserting in place thereof the following:- disability 34 And, in line 1 of subsection A of section 103 of chapter 93, by inserting after the 35 "reasonable" the following:- or without reasonable accommodation, 36 SECTION 8. Section 24E of chapter 111, of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 37 Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended in the second paragraph on line 8 by deleting the 38 word "handicap" and inserting in place thereof the following:- disability 39 SECTION 9. Subsection(a) of section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws, as so 40 appearing in the Official Edition of 2010, is hereby amended on line 11 by deleting the word 41 "handicap" and inserting on place thereof the following:- disability 42 And, by deleting in section 25 of chapter 161A on line 21 the words "handicapping condition" and inserting in place thereof the following:- disability 43 44 SECTION 10.
