*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1                   SECTION 1. Section 105D of chapter 149 of the 2010 Official Edition of the  
2 general laws is hereby amended by adding after the period in line 14, the following language:-  
3                   "An employee on maternity leave for the adoption of a child shall be entitled to the same  
4 benefits offered by her employer as an employee on maternity leave for the birth of a child."
