An act relative to the protection of public housing residents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 40 of chapter 121B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the last paragraph:-

3           (i) A housing authority shall not provide such housing to any person who is convicted of  
4 a public nuisance crime as defined by section 93(1) of chapter 93D.
