An Act relative to request an investigation by the attorney general into the following incidents in the town of Templeton.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
2 citizens of the Town of Templeton hereby request an investigation by the Attorney General into
3 the following incidents:

4 An investigation into the activities of the Municipal Building Committee to include all
5 transactions regarding the purchase of the 252 Baldwinville Road property and the USDA loan
6 application process.

7 An investigation into the procedures and activities to allow the settlement and return of a
8 gift of \$369,681.40 to Casella Waste Systems on November 13, 2008.

9 An investigation into the activities of the Templeton Board of Selectmen and the
10 Templeton Municipal Light Department to enact Chapter 93 Acts of 2000.

11 An investigation into the activities and actions of legal counsel, Kopelman & Paige,
12 regarding case 02-2424C heard before Judge Cornetta of Worcester Superior Court as well as the
13 settlement of the Templeton Waste Water Treatment plant lawsuit and the Writs of Attachment.
