In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act requiring police notification to certain neighbors of level 2 sex offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 178K of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word “Investigation.”, in line 124, the following
3 sentences:-

4 The police department in the municipality where a level 2 offender’s primary residence,
5 and secondary residence if any, is located shall provide notice to all immediate abutters of the
6 following information: the name of the offender, his home address, work address, the offense(s)
7 and date(s) for which the offender was convicted or adjudicated, the offender’s age, sex, race,
8 height, weight, eye and hair color and a photograph of the offender, if available. Such notice
9 shall include a warning regarding the criminal penalties for use of sex offender registry
10 information to commit a crime or to engage in illegal discrimination or harassment of an
11 offender and the punishment for threatening to commit a crime under section 4 of chapter 275.
